

Meeting held in the Village Hall on 28<sup>th</sup>  
January, 1971.

The Treasurer stated that the final account of £169 to Mr Wyatt was due. The committee agreed that this should be paid on the proposal of Mr Haynes, seconded by Mrs Turner.

The committee agreed to pay Mrs Brinkhurst £20-00 from 15<sup>th</sup> January, 1971. Proposed Mrs Turner, Seconded by Mr Jones. The Treasurer stated that the Hall Funds were on the increase but the painting of the interior and exterior of the hall had to be done and new equipment - cutlery, cabinets, tables and crockery was required.

The committee was told that the fête raised £25-30 for the funds.

The meeting was opened by Mr Tasker, apologising for the cancellation of the A.G.M. This was because Mr Garner had not audited the accounts. The meeting in July had had to be cancelled because too many of the committee would be away.

The Treasurer stated that the final repayment of the loan had been paid to the Parish Council.

Mr Tasker and Mr Haynes had seen the County Council about the library lease. The lease was now for 5 years at £60-00 per annum. The electricity was to be monitored and paid for as used in addition to the £60-00 per annum.

Mrs Brennan proposed, Mrs Turner seconded that the terms of the lease be accepted.

Carried.

Mr Jones reported that the hall had been damaged by the Youth Club. Mr Tasker also commented on the state of the Hall after use by the Club. It was agreed that the Youth Club be given 3 months notice of the termination of their use of the Hall unless supervision improved.

It was agreed to buy a 7'x3' cupboard for £16-00 and cutlery for £32-00 from Bodwells. The committee agreed to make up the crockery. Once these had been done a fee and a deposit would be required for the use of the crockery and cutlery.

Mr Tasker was asked to see that the wall was built to keep people off the roof.

It was agreed to hire the hall to Mr Kibble for a New Year Party subject to certain conditions being agreed.

It was agreed to raise the fee for the Hall to £1 per hour

£7-85 to the "parish".

and £8-90 to "outsiders".

The committee agreed that the next meeting should be called by the Chairman.

Minutes of the Meeting held 18<sup>th</sup> May 1972 in the Hall. Mr Tasker in the Chair.

The minutes of the meeting held in November were read.

The Chairman apologised for the A.G.M. not taking place. The accounts were still in a state of flux. Mr Jones agreed to check the accounts after Mr Tasker had prepared them.

Mr Tasker presented the lease for the library. Rent £60 per Annum. Electricity paid for by County Council.  
Mr Haynes reported that the Polisher was out of action. Mr Horsington and Mrs Turner proposed and seconded that a new one costing £60-70 be purchased.

It was agreed, on the proposal of Mrs Haynes (see Mr Horsington), to buy a portable scaffold 10-12ft high for painting and cleaning the Hall.

It was agreed to rent an industrial vacuum cleaner @ 50 pence per hour (Proposed Mr Jones Seconded Mrs Turner)

It was proposed by Mr Haynes Seconded by Mrs Horsington that Mrs Burton be paid £24 per month.

It was agreed that the Boys Club use the Committee room for six months provided the Room was available for the Townswomen Guild and that it was supervised at all times.

It was reported that the wall had not been completed nor had any work been done on the stage.

It was decided to buy new buffet tables when funds were available.
