

Minutes of the A.G.M. held in Mortimer Hall  
on Monday Dec. 15th 1980

Several people attended the meeting.

Mr. Laske was appointed Chairman pro tem. As Treasurer he said end of 1979 £758.29½ remained in the account. Maintenance was heavy, over £460 for cleaning etc. The present year had been the worst for bookings, but regulars came back. When Hall started lots of willing helpers came forward but now there was practically no help at all. Everything is so expensive but he said the best had been done to keep the Hall running. Floor needs repairing & this will be very costly.

The Youth Club had finished through lack of leaders. Bingo still continued and produced about £8 a week. Mr. Horington has resigned as Vice-Chairman.

There was a discussion again re the installation of a pay telephone. Initial cost of installation would be £60 and ~~and~~ although the Play Groups were anxious for this to be done, the Committee opposed it as there were many other priorities. It was agreed the Play Group explore the possibility of ~~taking~~ taking over the entire responsibility.

Play group also asked about curtains. Chairman reported the fittings were only temporary & volunteers were needed to fix these properly.
